Golden Eagles and Silver Falcons Requirements: **Communication 2014/03**

Dear SAFSA Council members,

As per the Council's electronic vote concluded on the 9th June 2014, the following proposal was unanimously approved for implementation for the season commencing on 1 July 2014.

The Golden Eagles men and ladies programs for the non national sections will have their program length reduced by 30 seconds. The new length will be 3:00 minutes for ladies(+ - 10 seconds) and 3:30 for men(+ - 10 seconds). In addition, the jumping elements have also been reduced. The following will be applied for the 2014/2015 season:

A maximum of six (6) jump elements for ladies (previously 7) and seven (7) for men (previously 8) individual jumps, jumps combinations and jump sequences. There may be up to three (3) jump combinations or sequences. Only one jump combination can contain three (3) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted. One of the jump elements must be an axel type jump.

The Silver Falcons men and ladies programs for the non national sections will have their program length reduced by 30 seconds. The new length will be 2:30 minutes for ladies(+ - 10 seconds) and 3:00 for men(+ - 10 seconds). In addition, the jumping elements have also been reduced. The following will be applied for the 2014/2015 season:

A maximum of five (5) jump elements for ladies (previously 6) and six (6) for men (previously 7) individual jumps, jumps combinations and jump sequences. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Only one jump combination can contain three (3) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted. One of the jump elements must be an axel type jump
