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### ATHLETE TYPE DEFINITIONS

- A Type A athlete is a South African citizen regardless of where he or she may train or reside.
- A Type B athlete is a South African permanent resident or a South African temporary resident who has been a permanent or temporary resident of South Africa for more than one (1) year and who can provide proof that he/she has been resident in South Africa for more than six (6) months in the twelve 12 month period immediately preceding the holding of the competitive event.
- A Type C athlete is a South African temporary resident who has been a temporary resident of South Africa for more than one (1) year and who cannot provide proof that he/she has been resident in South Africa for more than six (6) months in the twelve 12 month period immediately preceding the holding of competitive event.
- A Type D athlete is neither a South African citizen nor a South African permanent or temporary resident and therefore does not fall in the preceding competitor classifications of Type A, Type B or Type C.

Type C and Type D athletes cannot be entered directly into the National Championship. The Province of the athlete must submit an application to the Council for consideration to invite the athlete to participate in the National Championships no later than 26<sup>th</sup> of April 2016. The respective Provinces will be informed of the outcome of the Council decision.
