

S**PERMITS****1 Authorisation and Application****1.1 Permits for Individuals**

A Provincial Committee may, by permit in writing, authorise eligible members to take part in Exhibitions, Carnivals, Displays, or Shows with or at the same time as anyone who is ineligible subject to meeting the provisions of clause 15.3. Application for permits must be made in writing fourteen (14) days before the permit is required, on the prescribed form (Appendix No. 10) to the Provincial Committee with whom the skater is registered. The granting of any permit is subject to any terms and conditions imposed by the Provincial Committee including the payment of any fee. Applications must be signed by the parent or guardian of any applicant under the age of 18 years.

1.2 Permits for Competitions

Any Association or Club not affiliated to SAFSA, or any individual(s) proposing to hold an ice skating competition or any affiliated club or clubs proposing to hold a competition open to members of two or more affiliated clubs or other eligible skaters who are not members of an affiliated club, which are to be held under SAFSA rules shall apply in writing to a Provincial Committee for a permit.

1.3 Expenses

A detailed list of expenses, if any, incurred by a skater which are, or to be reimbursed to a skater, accompanied by vouchers, must be forwarded with the permit to the Provincial Secretary of the Committee concerned immediately after the exhibition, show or competition.

1.4 Provisos

The following provisions shall apply to all permits;

- 1.4.1 A program is forwarded to the Secretary of the Provincial Committee concerned.
- 1.4.2 A representative of the Association is afforded free admission to the rink where the performances take place.
- 1.4.3 The permit is displayed at the place of the exhibition, show or competition on all days to which the permit applies.
